The body of the abstract should be written in Times New Romans font, size 12. Page margins are set all around 2.5 cm (0.98"). The abstract should be written on a single page, limited to a maximum of 250 words in 4 paragraphs with the subtitles: Background, Methods, Results and Conclusion. The whole abstract should be justified on both sides, with single line spacing.

Abstracts must not contain figures, tables, or references. Abstracts not adhering to the aforementioned formatting requirements will be rejected.

**Deadline for receiving the abstracts is June 20 th, 2023.** Accepted abstracts will be published in the conference abstracts book.

Abstracts will undergo a reviewing process. Accepted abstracts should show novelty and integrity. If accepted, an e-mail will be sent to the author to confirm acceptance of the abstract. Participation in the conference is only confirmed upon payment of the required conference registration fees. A scanned copy of the receipt should be sent to the conference official email ([icps@must.edu.eg](mailto:icps@must.edu.eg)) in a message entitled "Receipt of conference registration".

The organizing committee reserves the right for minor editing changes (e.g. English editing, formatting, etc.). Significant changes will be referred to the author.
