Accepted Certificates

Misr University for Science & Technology accepts students holding the following certificates:

- The Egyptian General Secondary Certificate of Education (Thanawiya Amma) (Arts, Math or Sciences) and the Thanawiya Amma from other Arab country, Stem, Azhar
- The American High School Diploma.
- The French Secondary School Certificate
- The German Secondary School Certificate (Abitur).
- The British Secondary School Certificates
- The International Baccalaureate.
- Canadian High School Diploma.
- Nile Certificate

General Requirements for all certificates

- Original Birth Certificate issued in the same year of admissions.
- Copy of Student's National ID (Egyptian Students only)
- Copy of Father's National ID (Egyptian Students only)
- Student's Passport (Non-Egyptian Students)
- 6 Recent passport-size photos
- Military Service Form "Namozag 2+Namozag 6 Gond" (Egyptian males only)
- "Movement certificate holder must bring
 "Movement certificate" "شهاده تحركات" from the
 General Department of Passports, Immigration
 and Nationality in Egypt that is compatible with
 the academic year of high school.

Requirements for Transfer Students (from other universities

- Transfer students must meet admission standards, including obtaining a High School Certificate with a score that complies with the Supreme Council of Egyptian Private Universities regulations for the relevant year.
- To apply, students must submit certified transcripts from an authorized university that include detailed course descriptions, credit hours, and grades.
- After being officially accepted into the university, students will need to provide a letter from their previous university proving their withdrawal from the university.
- The Ministry of Higher Education must approve the transfer of courses, and they must be substantially similar to Misr University's courses in terms of both content and quality.
